    - ➤ Recommends a review and update to Article 1109. Recommends ORC to consider current International Property Maintenance Code as a basis for review. Mayor recommends this is an immediate need to assist Town and OCO to have better regulations for enforcement regarding historical preservation.
    - ➤ Recommends thorough review of Codified Ordinances regarding selection, nomination, and appointments of all members to Town Commissions and Committees. Recommends result of that review to prepare and develop a consistent method and process for selection, nomination, and appointments of all members to Town Commissions and Committees.
    - ➤ Recommends meeting with Chief Brown to discuss concerns regarding PART THREE Traffic Code and other issues the Police Department may have.
