November 5, 2020, seconded, passed unanimously.

Water Superintendent's Report Water loss at 45% though a leak on Jefferson Street was found and repaired that was causing a loss of over a million gallons a month, which will dramatically reduce our water loss. Overall usage is down, and leak detection efforts have been stepped up. The dumpster for the sludge removal from the lower sedimentation basins is in place, and removal efforts will begin 10/26, the same day that the new OIT employee starts.
