Request for Bid Proposal

The Corporation of Harpers Ferry is seeking bids for the following project.

Renovation of one Ladies and one Men's bathrooms located on the first floor of the Town Hall, 1000 Washington Street, Harpers Ferry, WV. Each bathroom is 10 feet x 5 feet. Renovation shall include:

- Remove and dispose of all old fixtures (2 commodes, 2 sinks w faucets, 1 urinal).
- Install one new commercial grade commode & flush handles in each bathroom.
- Install one new commercial grade urinal & flush handles – men's room only.
- Install one commercial grade sink with standard grade faucet in each bathroom.
- Install a new ceiling light fixture with exhaust fan in each bathroom.
- Sand, prime and paint bathroom partitions in each bathroom.
- Clean, remove any mold spots and paint all the walls in both bathrooms.
- Replace 12' x 12' vinyl floor tile and cove base in each bathroom.
- Install new ceiling tile in both bathrooms.

Retain and reuse the following items in each bathroom:

- Existing metal privacy panels.
- Existing handicap rails.
- Existing paper towel dispenser.
- Existing soap dispenser.
- Existing wall mirror.

Applicants must be licensed contractors in the State of West Virginia and must hold a current Harpers Ferry Business License. Evidence of same must accompany the bid. Work to be performed Monday through Friday, 8:00 am – 4:00 pm. Bids are due by Thursday, August 10, 2023, and shall be mail to Corporation of Harpers Ferry, Attn: Administrative Officer, PO Box 217, Harpers Ferry, WV 25425 or may be delivered to the office located at 1000 Washington Street, 2nd floor, Harpers Ferry, WV 25425.
