

Tree Work Plan for 2026 (updated 6/8/26)

Tree Work to be done by contractor:

Washington Street:

Gazebo Park:

Large silver maple on east side: remove.

Large English walnut tree in Washington St ROW midway in park: remove.

Large red maple tree on west side: remove large branch on west side trimmed repeatedly by power company.

Union Square Park

Crown prune the large red maple in the middle.

Remove the leaning box elder on edge of wood to the east of the maple.

740 Washington St: Crown prune hawthorn on east side.

1000 Washington St:

East side of town hall: elevate/trim back the 2 Bradford pears over parking and building

Elevate locust trees next to green dumpsters in parking lot behind town hall/post office

Church St:

South of 241; across from 231 High St, remove Norway maple that is leaning over trail.

West Ridge Street:

1230 over mature cherry tree: remove and grind stump. *(Removal added when Viking arborist determined tree was failing from black knot.)*

1182, crown prune crabapples.

1150 (west of): remove most southerly trunk/limb of elm.

1128 east of house: crown prune Styrex japonica on top of slope.

990 West Ridge St - in front of little green house. Remove locust and mulberry.

Side yard of 1000 West Ridge (on Franklin St side): remove small cedar; remove southernmost of the large trees (Norway maple) on top of the embankment.

Cambridge Street:

Tree at north end of gravel street: remove box elder

Side yard of 1171 W Ridge: elevate pear tree (multi-trunk)

East Ridge St

800: crown prune Kwanza cherry

West end of East Ridge: maple tree in the middle of the ROW, elevate north side to match work done on south side.

Gilmore Paper Street (north of E. Ridge):

Remove east side of the 2 American holly trees. *(Added when it was determined the ivy vines were as big as the tree trunk.)*

Henry Clay St

Midway from Washington to York Streets: remove 2 small boxelder trunks leaning from left to right.

Fillmore St.

338/316 Fillmore. Grind stump if possible.

East of 316 Fillmore: Grind stump of tree removed.

370, across from: elevate Kentucky coffee tree.

524 crown prune crabapple tree.

576, east property line: grind little stump.

700 block, south side, west side of brick walkway: crown prune small linden.

800 block of Fillmore, beside Mather Pl (driveway west of brick walkway): remove weight on both sides to aid silver maple in healing damaged area.

915 Norway maple/elm: remove dead limbs, limbs over house and elevate over road.

Boundary St

Near intersection with Fillmore: remove small boxelder tree that leans over street.

Franklin paper street (north of Putnam St).

Mulberry close to fence that is leaning toward the brick house (1066 Putnam): remove.

Putnam Court:

105: Remove silver maple tree that has limbs heading over road.

Young Paper Street, north of Fillmore

Remove big limb over power line to 370 Fillmore Street

Red trail from W Ridge to E Ridge:

Have Viking arborist Erik Berndt evaluate trees in paper streets for health and risk. Have him give recommendations on where additional trees should be planted in the right of way to reduce spread of invasive species.

Tree Work to be done by volunteers

Kill cluster of small ailanthus east of 1023 Putnam Street.

Kill cluster of ailanthus on east side of 897 Fillmore Street.

Remove lower limb of big linden on Fillmore across from end of Storer College Place

Crown prune small new trees: (NEED TO MAKE LIST OF THESE TREES)

884 Washington St: flowering plum

Clean basin and mulch all the trees with cages or stakes.

Adjust cage size of trees on the attached chart.

Eradicate ivy on street trees as needed. (NEED TO MAKE LIST OF TREES WITH IVY)

Gilmore Paper Street trees, north of East Ridge: walnut and holly tree that isn't being removed.

Franklin Street (side yard of 1000 W Ridge).

Plant small trees Robert and Christy have been growing

Tree Work to be done next year

Washington Street:

Gazebo Park:

Grind stumps of the two trees removed: large silver maple on east side and English walnut next to Washington Street.

West Ridge Street:

990 West Ridge St - in front of little green house. Grind stumps of locust and mulberry removed in 2026.
